Rotary Club of Ramna has provided rehabilitatio n assistance to families affected by the severe floods in Feni.	Rehabilitation of flood-affected people is more difficult than distribution of relief. After the flood waters receded, the affected people returned from the shelters to their homes to find their houses washed away or destroyed by the flood waters. The Rotary Club of Ramna extended humanitarian aid to the flood-affected people in various unions and villages of Feni district, which was flooded by the worst flood in the history of Bangladesh. 35 bun tins and 28 pillars of houses, mattresses for beds, PVC boards for partitions in houses, and butterfly sewing machines are distributed to 27 families for the purpose of rehabilitating people affected by floods to make them self-reliant. Additionally, as part of their rehabilitation efforts, they distributed 25 kg of rice, pulses, oil, soap, baby food, milk, and other food items to individuals living at the marginal level. Upon arriving here, we witnessed individuals leading extremely vulnerable and inhumane lives. The situation is so fragile that we feel like we have come forward with only a drop of water in the midst of an ocean of scarcity. I will ask people from all levels of the country to stand by these individuals. But if we bring more support, we could stand next to many more families. But we primarily tried our best. There were many questions from the locals: whether we will bring help again? We replied that, if possible, we will come again to stand by everyone. As previously mentioned, members of the Rotary Club of Ramna "Partner Club" Rotaract Club of Ramna have been actively working on this project. Also, they have been given maximum support locally by many brothers in that area. The training of 160 school children aged between 8 to 16 years was held in groups in 8 class rooms. The constrained condition of lack of assembly space led to separate class room arrangements of the training. In a way this allowed more interaction between trainer and trainees. I am sharing my overall experience briefly in the following paragraphs; - Probha Aurora is a certified UNEP volunteer organization and I am grateful to Bidhan Pal the CEO of the organization for planning and arranging training of members of Rotaract Club of Ramna to become trainers and participate in the school awareness event. Our Rotaract team can now spread their experience among other stakeholders and they can participate in national and international events with their knowhow. - The school lacks space yet the discipline that I have observed among students attending the program and their performance is laudable. 						general hospital. The institution is registered and managed by a board of trustees. TN Foundation has started rehabilitation programs for autistic children, blind and elderly persons since its inception in 2012. Of the outdoor patients 30% of the poor patients are provided free treatment in this hospital. A 50% discount is provided to patients on pathological tests, dental treatment, x-ray and 4D ultrasound tests. 27 ultra-old aged persons, 13 Autistic children & 17 Blind poor patients live in the hospital free of cost. It also provides all types of medical support and tests including medicines to them free of cost. Recently the financial grants of the government have been reduced largely causing financial difficulties which the hospital authorities are trying to make up through different measures without minimizing the facilities of the poor patients. Recently the hospital authority took an initiative for improvement of eye treatments. The Rotary Club of Ramna was requested to support an Auto-Refractometer for our Eye department. The hospital authority is very much grateful that RC Ramna provided a donation to enable the hospital to procure an Auto Refractometer equipment for the eye department.				Boliarpur, Savar, Dhaka

9	Flood Relief Campaign	08/25/2024	Service Project	Disaster (Flood)		In August 2024, Bangladesh faced severe flooding triggered by continuous heavy rainfall and, according to the Bangladesh Ministry of External Affairs, water releases from Dumbur Dam, upstream in Tripura, India, a claim that is denied by the Indian government. Tripura also suffered severe floods and landslides from this August. The flood impacted several districts in Bangladesh, including Feni, Noakhali, Cumilla, Lakshmipur, Brahmanbaria, Cox's Bazar, Khagrachhari, Chattogram, Habiganj, and Moulvibazar. By 23 August 2024, the Ministry of Disaster Management and Relief reported that floods had affected 4.5 million people across 77 upazilas in 11 districts. Nearly 194,000 people, along with over 17,800 livestock sought refuge in 3,170 shelters as the crisis continued. During that period, the members of Rotary Club of Ramna pledged to provide essential rations to 200 waterlogged families of Dharmapur and Mohammad Ali unions of Feni district which was among worst affected.
