Society for Education & Care of Hearing Impaired Children of Bangladesh, better known as HICARE was established in 1980. It has been working with a view to train the Deaf & Hearing Impaired children to learn to speak with an ultimate goal to integrate them to the mainstream education system. In 2 phases, 15 members of Rotary Club of Ramna with their kind contribution provided hearing aid to 6 children of the center. A follow-up visit took place on 15 May 2025 to interact with the HICARE officials, guardians and the children. HICARE also provided a progress report during the visit. All six children have made significant progress with the hearing aids. They are able to speak, hear and respond to sound and instructions.
